Three-week Program in English Conversation and American Culture

Conversation Classes	Intensive, highly interactive classes challenge students to increase their oral fluency in English. Focus is on practical communication in class, on campus, and in the community.
Levels	Placement test on first day places students into one of five levels: Basic, High Basic, Intermediate, High Intermediate or Advanced.
Interchange	Students work on conversation skills and build friendships with University of Hawai'i students. Interchange is held two times each week during class time.
Off-campus Class Activities	Using English with Americans in the community is an important part of the curriculum. Students enjoy learning about Hawaii while speaking English with community people.
Optional Excursions	Students may sign up for fun and interesting activities in the afternoons, evenings, or on weekends. <i>Examples: Hiking, snorkeling, sightseeing tours, concerts, movie on the beach</i>



Eligibility

Participants must be 16 years or older. If under 18 years, student must have an adult sponsor in Hawai'i.

Visa Information

Student visa is not required because this program is considered part-time. Participants may enter the U.S. on a tourist visa (or visa waiver).

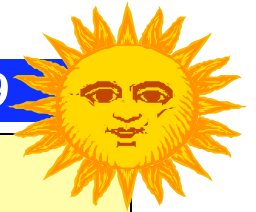
